# Paper Format and Style

A <u>template file</u> in Word format is provided in the website of the conference, and the authors are requested to use the template to prepare their full length paper for PRIC-WJT2009.

# Page Setup

Page: A4 (21.0cm ×29.7cm) with margins of 2.5cm top and down; 2.0cm left and right.

Text format: two columns, each column width 8.12 cm and the separation between the columns 0.75 cm.

But, abstract should be set in single column with lift & right indents of 10mm.

Paper Title: 14 pt Arial, Centered on full width of page

Authors: 9 pt Time New Roman, Centered on full width of page, 1 extra lines spacing backward & forward

- \* Author name: First name, Middle initial, LAST NAME
- \* Author's affiliations should denoted by superscript of small letter, and then given in footnotes at low-left corner.
- \* Email addresses of correspondence should be specified.
- \* Footnote: 8 pt Time New Roman, with minimum 12 pt line spacing, positioned flush left at the bottom of the column, a solid line between text and the footnote.

Abstract: 9 pt Time New Roman (or equivalent typeface), justified, with fixed 12 pt line spacing

Keywords: 8 pt Time New Roman, with 1 extra lines spacing backward & forward

Heading and Sub-Headings: 9 pt Arial, with minimum 12 pt line spacing

Text: 9 pt Time New Roman, with minimum 12 pt line spacing

## **Equations:**

Apart from the body of the text and centered, one line space between equations and text

Numbered consecutively, using Arabic numerals enclosed in parentheses and positioned flush right

### Graphics:

Numbered consecutively and captioned

Caption: 9 pt Time New Roman, centered, with fixed 12 pt line spacing

Sizing: graphics should be sized to fit width of one column, or to fit the span two columns

Letters within the graphic should be no smaller than 8 pt.

Spacing: enough space to separate graphic from text and other elements

Positioning: within body of paper after first reference or at end of text portion of paper

#### Tables:

Numbered consecutively and captioned

Caption: 9 pt Time New Roman, centered, with fixed 12 pt line spacing

Letters within the table should be no smaller than 8 pt.

Positioning: within body of paper after first reference

Spacing: enough space to separate table from text and other elements

Acknowledgements: 8 pt Time New Roman, justified, with fixed 12 pt line spacing

References: 8 pt Time New Roman, numbered consecutively, justified, with fixed 12 pt line spacing
